
- The factory wire harness is located along the passenger's side frame rail, near the spare tire. (Figure 1)
- Depress tab and unplug factory harness. (Figure 2).
- Plug the Blade Harness into factory wiring. Ensure plugs audibly "click" into place. (Figure 3).








Disconnect rear view camera plug(s) on driver's side frame rail. (Figure 4 left) Remove tail gate and clean mounting surface w/isopropyl alcohol. With the Torx T27 driver, remove trim piece. (Figure 4 right)








If installing 60" Blade, remove support bracket w/Torx T40 socket and wrench. (Figure 5)

Install black plastic brackets with tape onto the back of tailgate light bar. One on each end, then evenly space out. Remove tape release liner on all brackets. Place light bar in chosen position on the bed of truck. Do not stick tape to truck until light bar is in correct position. Light bar wire should exit toward driver side of truck.







- Route the wires behind the bumper. Connect 4 pin connector and Weather Pack connector to Blade Harness *Note: Putco recommends using di-electric grease on 4 pin connector to help keep connection water resistant. Zip-tie wires and Blade driver box in safe location, away from debris, hot exhaust pipes, or pinch points.
- Test that the Blade functions work properly (brake, turn signals, reverse, and running lights). Reassemble tail gate and do not forget to plug in rear view camera.
